Why Build?

I-69 will bring jobs to the state of Indiana.

- According to the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT), 47,000 jobs are created for every \$1 billion invested in roads.
- I-69 will generate 4,600 additional permanent jobs by 2025 and 4,300 to 7,500 temporary jobs that include construction related employment.

I-69 will serve as an economic development engine.

- New employers require good access to transportation.
 - Toyota built in Princeton near highway 41 and I-64.
 - General Motors built in Fort Wayne off I-69.
 - Wal-Mart and Dollar General are building regional warehouses in Marion off I-69.
 - New High Tech parks are springing up in Indiana off I-69, I-74, and I-65.
- I-69 will generate \$3.5 billion in additional personal income growth.
